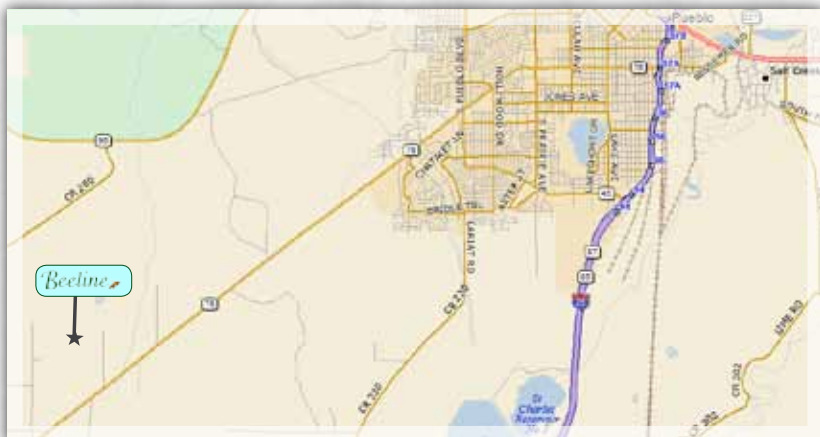

What's this stuff like?

We'll describe our woodenware as honestly as we can and hope your purchase matches your expectation. Want something we don't offer? Custom projects and modifications will be considered.

Wood grade options:

Woodenware grades have historically been divided into three grades—select, commercial, and budget. Those grades are all still available from Beeline, however, in this catalog we are providing pricing for only two choices that we have found to be most popular—commercial and mill-run. If you are interested in select or budget, feel free to contact us.

Select is available at higher prices and is as near to perfect as we can humanly and practically get it. No knots of consequential size. Splits or milling defects are not allowed at time of milling. Some variation in the width of box panels, especially in the deep hive bodies can occur. This is largely due to unavoidable shrinkage after milling. Handholds may have a little chipping at the end.



For **Commercial**, our objective is structural soundness. There will be no holes or potential holes, splits of great significance (short splits are passed), or milling defects. We attempt to keep knots at least 1 1/2" from nailing areas (ends of box side panels) but can make no guarantees. Knots, sometimes rather large, are allowed within the panel and on the edges as long as they are structurally sound.



We attempt to turn the best face out and pass it by commercial standards. Missing knots on the inside of the edges are permitted as long as half of the thickness of the panel is sound. We try to miss knots when we put in handholds. Again, there may be some variation in panel width due to post-milling shrinkage.

Millrun is roughly 50% Commercial and 50% Budget. Minimal milling defects and large knots can be found, but also many clean and knot free panels. Overall, when you get millrun, you can be pretty confident you are getting structurally sound woodenware for cheaper prices than Commercial.



Budget is the lowest grade. This grade may contain milling defects and large knots, but we try to keep them out of the nailing areas. In general, our budget has all the structural soundness and functionality of commercial.



Since we generate this grade by grading down from better grades, it is an accumulative product and frequently unavailable. Contact us for availability and pricing.

Assembling

If you choose to assemble yourself, we recommend several methods for fastening our products. Please ask for our free Assembly Instructions Booklet, on page 52 for directions. Also, see pages 53 & 54 of this catalog for some of our suggested fasteners.



When we assemble, we use jigs, some automated machinery, and other methods to ensure a square and correct finished product. We fasten everything with air staplers. Frames and Inner Covers come with the extra benefit of glue. If you desire other products to be glued, we can do so for an extra fee but we find our joints, stapled or nailed well, do not need glued for longlasting structural and functional integrity.

Keep in mind that assembly adds considerable bulk to a product and complications to shipping. We are willing to ship assembled and painted equipment but there will be extra shipping cost.

Copper-Dipping

Copper-dipping uses a copper monoethanolamine solution that inhibits rotting, and penetrates the joints, staple penetrations, and wood inside and out for a longer lasting box. It can be painted with any good grade oil or latex paint. Only available from the Michigan Branch.



Painting

We will attempt to give you the most economical, quality job possible. We are using a good grade of low sheen latex for two coats. We spray boxes and feeders on the stack which means that the upper and lower surfaces do not get painted. You may paint those surfaces if you want them painted. Lids and bottom boards get complete first coats. Sides and exposed surfaces are given a second coat. Because inner covers are usually not exposed we do not offer painting on them.



We use white unless otherwise specified. We can do any other color using basic color chips for reference. However we will charge an extra \$50 per color (non-white) per job for the extra labor required in getting and handling the special color.

We will try to allow plenty of drying time before shipping your painted product but it is impossible to ensure that they will come through with no damage. Latex painted surfaces will stick to each other for quite some time after the pieces have been painted and when it does, it can pull the paint on one of the pieces. We will try to pack to minimize this problem as well as chaffing damage. If you desire touch up paint we can arrange to send some along.

Introduction to Hive Parts



COVER / LID

The roof for your hive to keep the bees snug and dry. Beeline offers six styles. The Garden styles look nice in your back yard garden. The Telescoping Lid (pictured here) or the plastic Ultimate Hive Cover is most common for a back-yard beekeeper. Migratory or Plywood lids are made for commercial beekeepers stacking their hives on bee pallets.

INNER COVER

Buffer between lid and bees; can provide ventilation, especially if the Screened Inner Cover is used. The raised panel style (shown here) is the most common. Flat-sided inner covers work similarly to it. While the Screened Inner Cover is used mainly for ventilation in summer months.

TOP FEEDER

Used for feeding large quantities in early summer and late fall months. It would not be a good idea to use this style during the winter when your bees are in cluster. An inboard feeder (shown below inside Deep Hive Body) or a bag with several pin pricks set above the Brood Chamber works best for clusters.

SHALLOW SUPER

This is where the bees put the honey. Beeline offers two sizes of supers, but recommends each beekeeper to choose one or the other and stick with that. This size is nice for ladies or the elderly who do not wish to carry as much weight. It also works well for comb honey harvesting. We also offer plastic or wax foundation for this size.

MEDIUM SUPER

This is where the bees put the honey. Beeline offers two sizes of supers, but recommends each beekeeper to choose one or the other and stick with that. This size is the most common super. We offer plastic or wax foundation for this size.

QUEEN EXCLUDER

A metal gridwork with holes large enough for worker bees, but too small for the queen; excludes the queen from laying eggs in the honey super.

DEEP HIVE BODY

The brood chamber and year-around home for the bees. Often two brood boxes are used to give the queen more room to lay her eggs. In winter you will reduce the hive to one or two boxes so that the bees can conserve their heat. Beeline offers either plastic or wax foundation for the frames.

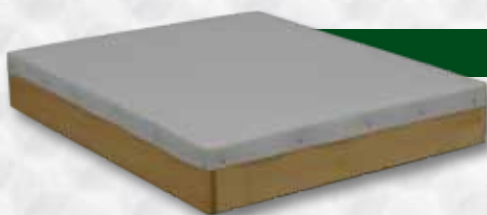

BOTTOM BOARD

The base of your hive, and "front door" where the bees enter and leave the hive. Beeline has two styles to choose from. The Screened Bottom Board (pictured here) is nice for ventilation and with the Mite Tray, is useful in monitoring your mite count. The Reversible style is the standard bottom board.

Telescoping Lid

The lid for the hobbyist. A 3" wide skirt with rabbeted corners make these lids heavier and harder to blow off. 3/8" plywood with a cover of .019 white aluminum forms a weatherproof top. This aluminum is pre-bent with a 1" drop on the sides and overlapping tabs on the corners to prevent leaking, and can be purchased alone.

Migratory Lid

The lid for the commercial beekeeper. The main part of this lid is made of tongue-and-groove. The end cleats fasten these together in a 1/4" deep groove with 1 5/8" for a skirt and 3/8" above. Another piece fastens flat-wise to the top. This piece also has a 3/8" thick lip to come out over the skirt pieces. This eliminates the crack that would allow water into the ends of the tongue-and-groove pieces. We recommend using long nails or 2" staples through that 3/8" lip and down through the end to bind it all together so that the skirts do not break off so quickly.

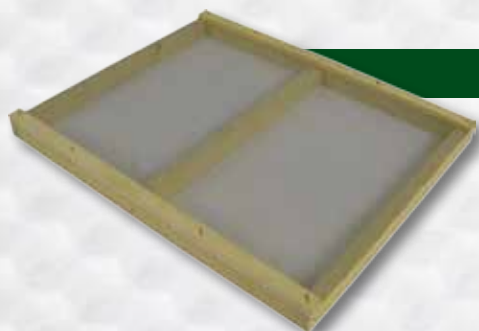

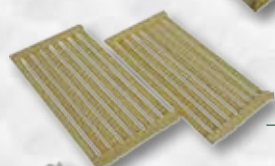

Top Feeder

With each compartment holding one gallon, this two compartment feeder sits on top of the hive boxes, just under the inner cover. Bees access the feeding area through an open slot that runs cross-ways in the middle. After syrup is poured into compartments, pine slatted floats can be placed on top of the syrup, preventing drowning. Or you can choose screen to cover the center bee slot and allow bees to suck syrup through screen holes. The bottom is recessed 1/8" to minimize rocking on burr comb left on the top bars of the box below it. When we assemble, seams will be caulked to ensure that it is leak-proof.

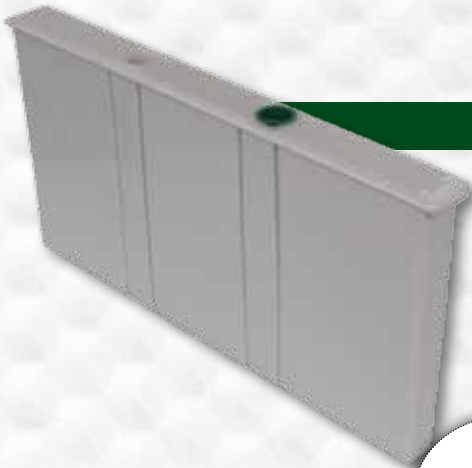

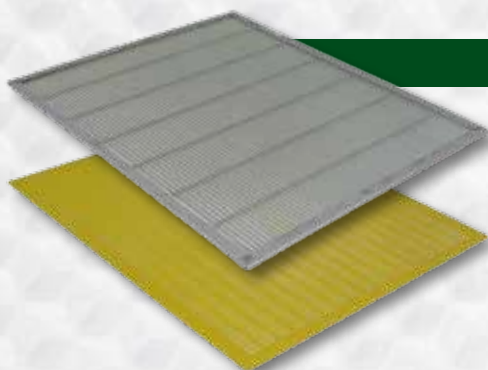

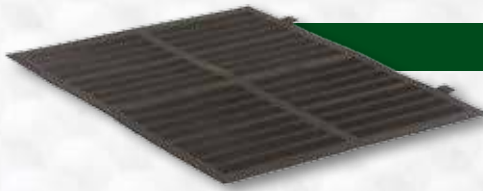

Propolis Trap

With this plastic propolis trap you can harvest quantities of clean propolis and sell a value-added product from your hive. Put on the top of your hive in the place of the inner cover, block the hive cover up so that light can get into the hive. The bees will fill the cracks in the trap in an effort to block the light and seal the hive. To harvest place propolis trap into a plastic bag and freeze. Once frozen twist the trap inside the bag to release the propolis. Fall is the time of greatest propolis collection.

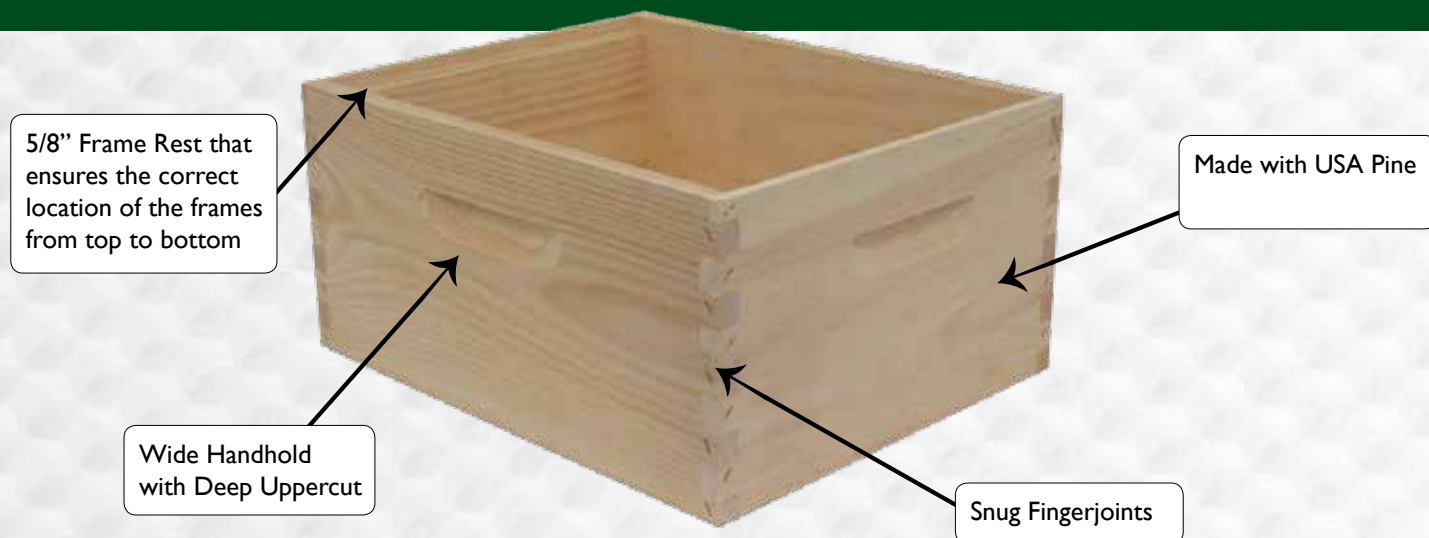

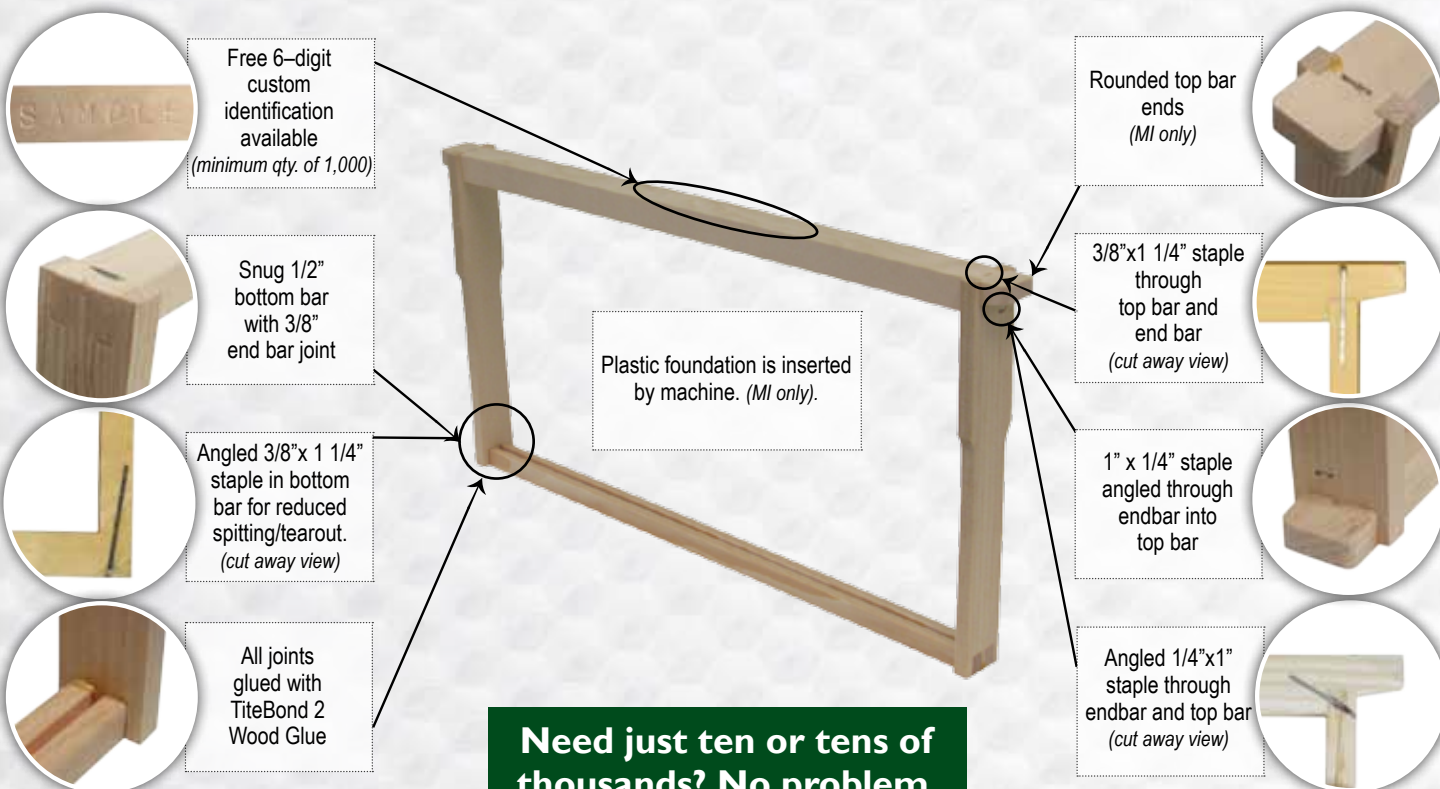

Green Drone Frames

For two reasons. Raise more drones of your favorite genetics to increase drone population for mating purposes. But perhaps more importantly, in this age of mites, use it as a tool to reduce mite population. Put these drone frames—you will always recognize them by their conspicuous off-green color—into the brood chamber. One per hive is enough. Pull the frame when the drone brood is capped and replace with another drone frame. Put the removed frame in the freezer. Repeat the cycle when the current frame is capped. Mites prefer drone brood and by doing this you will greatly reduce your mite population. But **WARNING!** Keep track of your timing! If those drones start emerging before you pull the frame, you have created a mite farm instead of a mite eliminator!

Beeswax Candle Molds

We are happy to offer you a collection of basic items for your candle making hobby! Our flexible molds will endure hundreds of pourings, leaving you satisfied with beautiful, exquisitely detailed candles again and again!

Steps to make candles:

1. Spray Mold Release (sold separately, below) lightly inside your mold.
2. Thread the wicking (sold separately, below) through the hole at the bottom of the mold, pictured at right, using a wicking needle or similar tool.
3. Pull the wick so that it is about 6" longer than the top of the mold. Leave the wick at the bottom of the mold long also, so that when you remove the candle, the mold will rewick itself.
4. Make sure the seam in the mold, pictured at right, is matched up as closely as possible.
5. Secure those seams with rubberbands which are included in your mold.
6. Secure the wick over the top of the mold (bottom of candle) using items like bobby pins or popsicle sticks. Keep the wick centered and straight but not too tight. Wick that is too tight or too loose will affect how your candle burns.
7. Pour your melted wax into the mold slowly and carefully.
8. Let your candle cool slowly. The slower, the better it will turn out.
9. When your candle is completely cooled, remove the rubberbands and pull apart the seam at the side of the candle.
10. Remove the candle from the mold and trim the wick at both ends.
11. Your mold is now wicked and ready for your next pouring. If the bottom of your candle is uneven, use a metal pie pan on the stove to gently warm the wax at the uneven bottom and flatten it out so the candle will sit level.
12. Light your candle for your own enjoyment, sell it for some extra profit, or give it away!

To place your order:

Small orders under 200 lbs. can be placed and paid for online at www.beelinewoodenware.com. A printable order form is also available online to download and fill out.

Or, you can call or e-mail your nearest Beeline branch (MI, CO, or WA) and be prepared to provide the following information:

1. Name
2. Mailing and Shipping address
3. Phone number
4. E-mail address (if you have)
5. Quantities and Catalog numbers for the products you are ordering.
6. Credit Card information including 3-digit code and billing address. (We do not recommend e-mailing credit card info. Please call instead.)

Payment Terms

We expect payment up-front for small orders in the form of credit card or check. For orders over \$500, we expect a 50% down payment before shipping, with the balance due within 30 days of ship date. We accept cash, check, or credit card payment. Please make all checks payable to "Beeline."

After 30 days from invoice date, the bill will be subject to a finance charge of 1.5% per month.

Shipping

Orders can be picked up at our facilities by appointment or they can be shipped to you.

We are using Fed-Ex Ground, US Postal Service or UPS for smaller boxed orders, and whichever LTL shipping company offers the best rate to your location for palletized shipments.

For estimates on small orders, calculate shipping using the chart on the next page along with the map below. We do not guarantee these rates and will always charge actual whether

lower or higher. Please call for a quote for orders over 200 lb. for assembled and painted woodenware. You may also want to check the dealership list on p. 66 and 67 to see whether you could drive for your wares.

Our products are priced for the material, labor, overhead, and profitability that they entail, and excludes any shipping considerations. We do not bury shipping expense in our product prices. Shipping and handling includes only what is entailed in shipping, and calculated as simply and accurately as we can: Fed-Ex, UPS or USPS's base charge, plus a charge to cover box, label, and tape cost, miscellaneous shipping charges, and labor to do the packing and labeling to ensure that your order will get to you in as small a box as possible and in good condition.

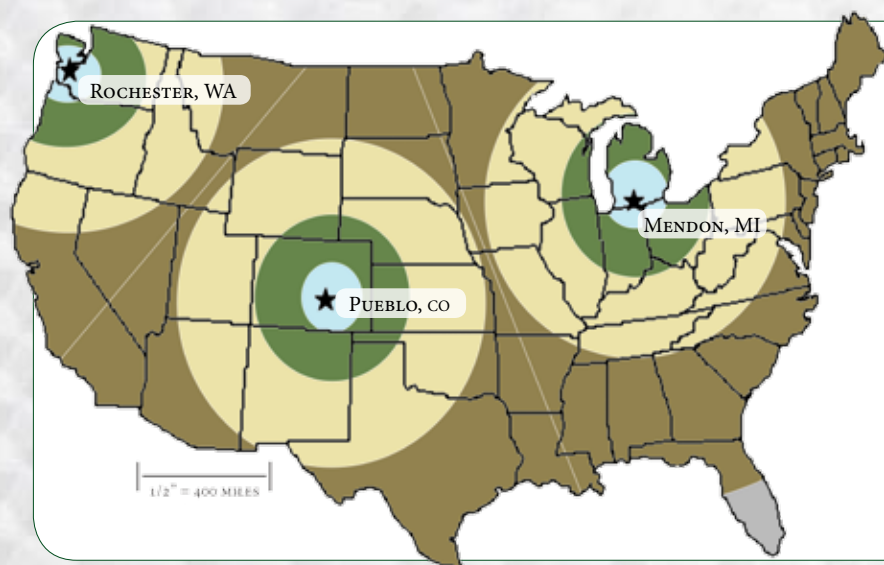
